This year is the 60th anniversary for the Type 1 Karmann Ghia, released in 1955 as a coupe, and in 1957 as a convertible. They were glamorous looking cars back then and still are today. They were produced until 1974 and over that time were kept up to date with various minor body changes (some not so successful!) and mechanically followed the Beetle updates. They produced a total of 364,401 coupes and 80,837 convertibles.

At the same time sixty years ago Volkswagen were celebrating the production of the 1 millionth Beetle, the famous Gold car with the Rhinestones on the bumpers etc. And what a celebration it was too, dealers from all the countries that sold VW's back then were invited to attend (wonder if anybody from NZ went ??) and they had a parade thru Wolfsburg with representatives from each of those countries taking part. They also built a huge Roulette Wheel with real Beetle cars around the outside acting as the numbers and a Beetle driving round on the inside acting as the ball. Not sure what the prizes were but I'm sure the crowd enjoyed it!

From there the "Kombined" convoy then proceeded out to out to Raglan for a picnic lunch and browse around the shops.




